Tuition fees for the 2020-21 school year are \$6700 and fees for International students are \$17,500.

Families in need of a family discount must complete a **Request for Family Discount Form** and submit it with your registration or re-registration package annually. Discounts are not automatically given to families with multiple children attending St. John Paul II Academy.

Please note that any amount taken as a family discount will be reflected as a decrease in the charitable portion of your tuition for which you receive a tax receipt.

Refundable Enrolment Deposit Program

The Enrolment Deposit program asks the families of students accepted into St. John Paul II Academy to contribute \$25,000 to the school that will be returned to the family when their child graduates or leaves the school. By introducing this program these funds can be used to help secure bank financing for the school's construction. While these funds are held by the school an interest payment to the family will be made on an annual basis for the duration that these funds are held.

Financial Assistance

St. John Paul II Academy is committed to providing accessible Catholic-based education to all families and does offer bursary support for those who would not otherwise be able to attend.

Financial aid is based on an annual assessment of demonstrated financial need. Demonstrated need is the difference between the cost of St. John Paul II Academy and the resources a family has to meet that cost. Please note that the school has limited funds available and may not always able to meet the financial needs of all families of applicants.
