There are so many remarkable achievements to highlight, one of which is in sports. It is an incredible testament to our athletes to win five banners in one year.

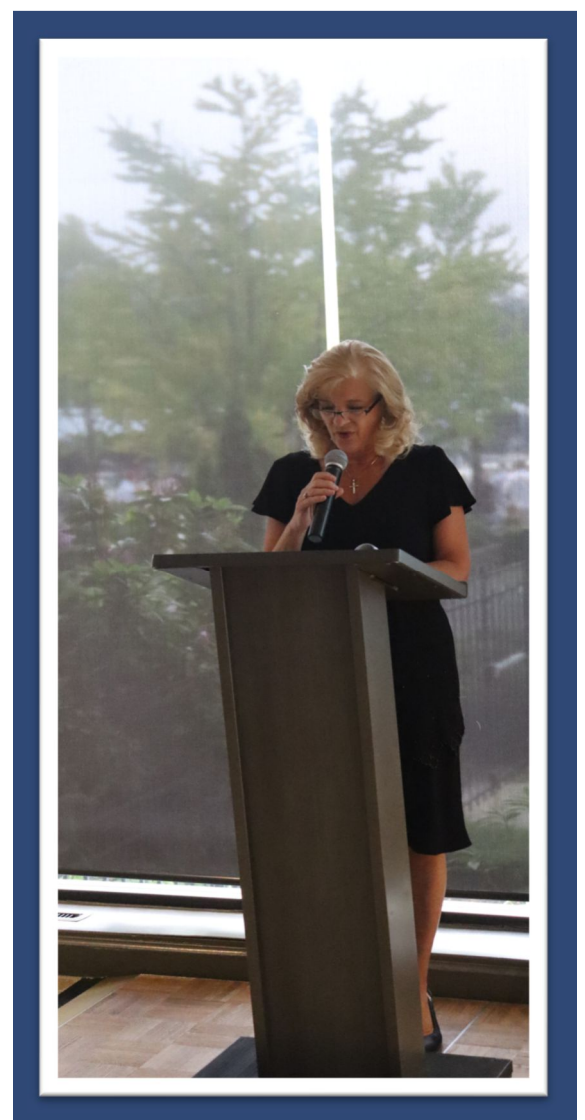
Academically, the students worked hard, participated in Math and Physics contests and self-reflection assessments and were celebrated at the Legacy Awards evening.

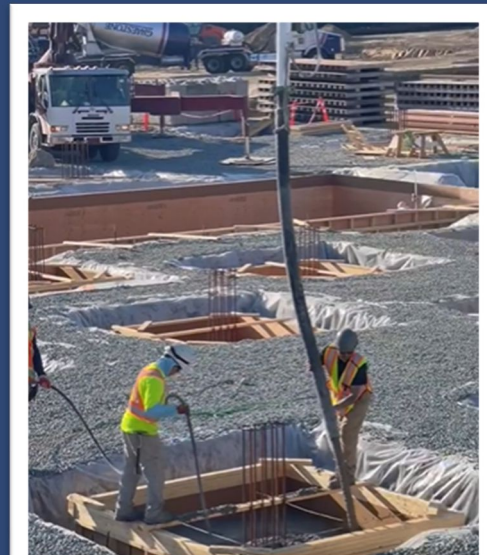
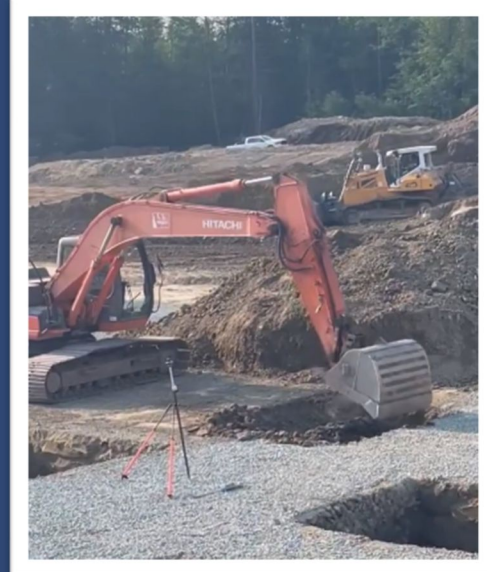
New Beginnings

On behalf of the foundation board, we wish you much success in all your future endeavors. We are confident that wherever you go, success will follow... Because you are royals!



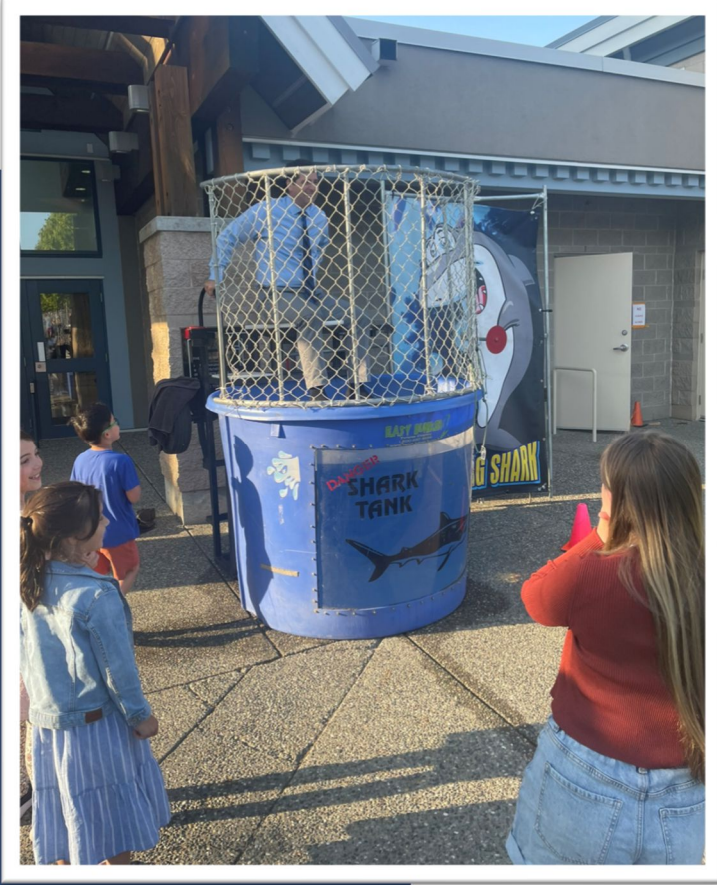
The Ceremony
