





A Note from Foundation Director Dr. Joseph King

Our family is grateful for the opportunity to become involved in the establishment of Saint John Paul II Academy, the newest Catholic high school in the Vancouver Archdiocese. In 2013, our family moved to BC's lower mainland from Seattle, Washington where our children had attended a Catholic elementary school. After our move to Canada, we found it important that our children continue to receive a Catholic based education and we were happy that we could enroll our children at Star of the Sea Elementary School in South Surrey. These established Catholic elementary schools exist today because parents of past students and contributing community members understood the tremendous value of a Catholic education for children and the world.

As our own children approached high school age, like many parents in the greater South Surrey area, we became increasingly aware of the need for a nearby new Catholic high school to serve a rapidly expanding population with growing numbers of families seeking a faith based high school education. We were delighted to join the grass roots initiative led by Troy Van Vliet to help build this much needed new high school.

With the vital support of Archbishop Miller, Father Dion and many others in this community, in the fall of 2018, Saint John Paul II Academy first opened its doors in the temporary facility in the old Star of the Sea Community Building in White Rock.



Our eldest son, William entered Saint John Paul II Academy as a member of the school's very first students in grade 8. In June 2023, William was one of the members of the graduating Legacy class- the first group of students to graduate from Saint John Paul II Academy. After receiving an excellent high school education at Saint John Paul II Academy, every one of SJPII Academy's class of 2023 achieved his or her first choice for post-secondary endeavors. William is happy to be attending the University of British Columbia this fall where he will study science. These first graduates of SJPII Academy played a very important role in establishing this high school that will serve and positively impact so many students, families and the world for generations. Our son, Charlie, now entering grade 10 at SJPII, will be a member of the first class to graduate from the new school campus currently under construction.

Why do we value a Catholic education and consider building Saint John Paul II Academy to be important now, both for our family and the community? The quality of academic instruction and the educational foundation of faith-based values are two key reasons. The wonderful teachers and staff at Saint John Paul II Academy understand that a quality education engages a student on all levels, including intellectually and spiritually. These educators teach their students literature, math, and science with excellence, while teaching the subjects within a greater context of each student's moral, and spiritual development.



The teachings of Christ are emphasized at SJPII, including values of kindness, compassion, empathy and the dignity of each human person. Christians are called to continue the tradition of the Apostles who handed on the faith and fought in defense of the faith, sharing Christ's message of salvation, hope and love and Catholic schools help share this message. For our greater school community including those who are not Catholic, Saint John Paul II Academy is helping students to discover the universal value of serving others while supporting our community through student led activities and volunteering.

In today's secular society where governments are often hostile to traditional faith traditions and seem quick to revise, cancel or replace traditional educational curriculum in efforts to promote a cultural ideology or political philosophy in schools, more than ever, our community and country needs independent alternatives like Saint John Paul II Academy. Government managed schools with a singular government approved curriculum should not be the only educational option in a multicultural and free society. Our society needs faith-based alternatives like Saint John Paul II Academy- where a traditional education includes fundamental truths about our humanity, biology, and each life's purpose. We have chosen to help support the establishment of Saint John Paul II Academy because at this moment in human history, building this school is so important for the future of both our local community and the world.

Building the Legacy


Independent schools, like ours, are a community benefit. This is because Independent Schools have no government funding. We don't receive funding for the construction cost nor the land and therefore none of the infrastructure is paid by the taxpayers, including roads. We are responsible to build roads around the entire school. Also, we are obliged to do a temporary school sewer connection. So, Saint John Paul will pay for it all which translates to tens of millions of dollars.

The entire community will benefit from this project because this initiative is not funded by taxpayer money. Therefore, the community receives a high school, that is so needed, and the money saved will go to other priorities that is required by community. We are still on schedule for September 2025. We look forward to celebrating the Opening Ceremonies. If you haven't registered yet, register now, and save your spot.


