Tuition Rates for 2025-26 School Year

The Society Board has established the tuition rates for the upcoming 2025-26 school year. A modest increase in tuition is necessary to account for:

- Inflation
- · Rising operational costs
- Preparation for the move to the new, permanent school campus in 2025

The provincial government funds independent schools at just 50% of the rate of public schools. In the absence of a provincial tuition voucher program, a tuition fee is necessary to cover operational expenses and ensure students receive the highest quality Catholic education possible.

Commitment to Accessibility

The Saint John Paul II Academy Society Board is firmly committed to ensuring that every Catholic student who wishes to attend the academy can do so, regardless of their family's financial circumstances.

Tuition Assistance

- Funding assistance is provided through a bursary program
- Funding is sourced from donors and fundraising events (such as the recent golf tournament and gala)
- · Families can apply for tuition assistance through the online Apple Financial portal
- · Contact Susan Kelly at the school office for application details

Application Process

- 1. Apply through Apple Financial (AFS)
- 2. AFS conducts a confidential financial evaluation
- 3. A recommendation is provided to the school

Additional Tuition Considerations

- · Applicants do not need to be Catholic
- A tuition discount is provided for Catholic families
- · An additional discount is offered for families with multiple students attending the school
