

Mental Health and Substance Use Resource for Parents

The Ministry of Education and Child Care, in partnership with adolescent clinical psychologist Dr. Hayley Watson from Open Parachute, will host three, free virtual sessions for parents, guardians and caregivers that will focus on practical skills you can teach your child and youth (ages 0-19) to prevent substance use and mental health needs. These sessions will build on a previous presentation that focused on practical conversation tools for discussing substance use prevention with your children/youth. The last session is not a prerequisite for this session. Go to: openparachute.ca to register.

Key takeaways for participants during this session:

- Learn the factors that lead to substance use and mental health needs from a trauma-informed lens
- Focus on prevention rather than intervention/response

Applies to parents, guardians and caregivers of all age groups (youth aged 0-5, 6-10, and 11-18) Learn ways that these skills can be applied to yourself and the rest of your family to support the mental health of parents, guardians and caregivers.


























































































St. John Paul II Society News
